Is your child looking for fun this summer?
Would you like your child to make new friends?

Have fun and make friends at Comm Camp. Together with the Northeast Pennsylvania Area Health Education Center, the Waverly Community House will host six weeks of recreation, friendship and learning for that special summertime experience. Campers are grouped by age and activities are planned accordingly. Each week's activities will revolve around a new theme.

Week 1 (June 29-July 2): "All American Week"

Celebrate America with an old-fashioned cook-out, lots of Americana and summer fun.

Week 2 (July 6-12): "Wild Safari Week"

Explore the world of animals and the wild outdoors.

Sponsored by a grant from the Overlook Estate Foundation.

Week 3 (July 13-17): "All Star Week"

A week filled with physical activity — Comm Camp Olympics, sports clinics and fun with healthy habits.

Week 4 (July 20-24): "Comm-istry Week"

Explore the world of scientific imagination and adventure with age-appropriate experiments, activities and more.

Week 5 (July 27-31): "Cirque de Comm & Carnival Week"

This week features juggling clowns, carnival activities and performers.

Week 6 (August 3-7):

"Lights, Comm-era, Action Week"

Our last week of camp is filled with creative fun. Campers prepare to display their talents at the annual camp talent show.

Week 7 (August 10-14):

Art Camp

New this year — Art Camp with NEIU rostered artist and instructor, Barry Singer in the Scout Room. Two sessions, Ages 8 to 11 and 12 to 18.

AGE GROUPS:

- Level 1 Pre-K and Kindergarten (Age 4by 9/30)
- Level 2 Entering Grades 1 or 2 in September
- Level 3 Entering Grades 3 or 4 in September
- Level 4: Entering Grades 5, 6 or 7 in September

Our staff to camper ratio is 1:8. Maximum group size is 28 children. Early registration is recommended to ensure your child's space.

THE STAFF: Our Camp Director, Morganne Gwynn, is supported by an assistant director, Dave Gwynn and a staff of head counselors (college students) assistant counselors (high school students) and counselors-in-training. Staff also includes physical education and arts and crafts directors. Administration is by the Comm's office staff with assistance from NEPA AHEC*.



REGULAR CAMP: Monday-Friday

9 am to 1pm All Levels: \$90 per week

Camp activities are designed to be age appropriate for each level. The gym, playground and Comm grounds will be used by each group at scheduled times.



Campers will be visited by guest coaches, instructors and performers. This summer's guests include *Duncan Perry-The Banjo Guy*, *Hiking Jane at the State Park* and others.

Programs are developed by the Comm, NEPA AHEC and camp staffs.

Levels 2, 3 & 4 will take weekly trips to Lackawanna State Park for swimming, nature walks and outdoor fun.

EXTENDED CAMP: 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. \$45 per week

Extended Camp will be run by at least two Head Counselors and will provide age appropriate groups and activities.

EARLY CAMP ARRIVAL: 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. \$20 per week

Early drop off is available. Campers will gather in the Pre-School Room and be escorted to their groups at 9:00 a.m.

COUNSELOR-IN-TRAINING PROGRAM: \$300/6 weeks

For girls and boys entering 8th, 9th or 10th grades, a Counselor-In-Training Program is available. Emphasis will be on creativity, problem solving skills and leadership skills. Cost is \$300 for the six weeks or \$100 per week up to three weeks. *Separate application required.*

LUNCH: Lunch is scheduled for one-half hour each day. Campers may bring lunch or order it at Camp. **Lunch money and forms are collected on Monday morning only.** The Lunch Menu is *Hot Dog or Pizza with Snack (\$1.50), Yogurt or Fruit (\$1.00) • Peanut Butter & Jelly with Snack (\$1) and Drinks (\$.75).* **Please do not include lunch money with camp fees.**



New this year, for campers Levels 3 & 4, CIT's and Family, Field Trip to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre Yankees Game, Friday, July 30th at 1:00 pm. \$20 per person includes transportation to and from stadium, free \$18 cap and program. Sign up at Camp!
