What is the Comm Kids Inclusive Learning Center?

The Comm Kids Inclusive Learning Center is a safe, sensory-friendly space where students with special needs and their support teams can meet for one on one instruction. This includes but is not limited to: tutors, occupational and physical therapists, speech and behavioral therapists and aides.

What can I find there?

As this is also a working preschool classroom, it is already equipped with a number of Early Childhood appropriate toys and manipulatives. At the suggestion of the University of Scranton Occupational Therapy Masters students, we have purchased additional fine and gross motor materials, art and sensory materials, flexible seating and more. These items are available for students and their support staff to use. Support staff are also most welcome to bring their own materials to use as well.

Where is it located?

The Comm Kids Inclusive Learning Center is located in the Comm Kids Pre-K Plus Classroom at the Waverly Community House. The classroom is around the back of the building next to the playground and to the right of the staircase.

When is the Inclusive Learning Center Open?

Summer hours will be Monday-Friday 9:00am-3:00pm School year hours will be Monday-Friday 2:00pm-6:00pm
