Our Program

<u>Our Philosophy:</u> The Comm has a long standing commitment to Early Childhood Education that dates all the way back to our first kindergarten class in 1921. Our children's programs reflect Paul Belin's idea of "education through recreation," something we believe wholeheartedly. We focus on the growth and well being of the whole child, both intellectually, and socially and emotionally. Children learn in a multitude of ways, and we make it our mission to incorporate as many of those ways into our curriculum as possible.

<u>Guided Free Play:</u> During this activity, children work on their social and emotional skills; specifically how to share and work together with others, as well as how to conquer physical and social obstacles.
